

SpeedWatch Report for 27 April 2026 RSPC Meeting

- A very successful session was held at 15.00 on 2 April 2026 at the A425/ Kingshurst junction. A total of 206 vehicles were detected and a total of thirteen were recorded exceeding the 30 mph speed limit by 5 mph or more. The fastest was recorded at 37 mph. We have received confirmation that all submissions were accurate and that thirteen warning letters were sent out. It was noted that at that time of the afternoon, traffic density was moderate (rather than heavy) giving ample opportunity to exceed the speed limit (in spite of our obvious presence).
- We have one new volunteer join our group, a lady from Bloxham Way. She has received her roadside safety and LASER operation training and will shortly be introduced to the group followed by joining a session together with two of our experienced volunteers in the very near future. We now have a total of 13 volunteers, but some are currently unavailable due to health considerations or other commitments so a new volunteer member of the team is very welcome.
