

SpeedWatch Report for 29 June 2026 RSPC Meeting

- A session was conducted on Tuesday 9 June at the A425 Lewis Road junction at 15.00. A total of 170 vehicles' speed was detected and 8 speeders recorded and reported. The highest speed recorded was 45 mph. One abusive chap was reported.
- In the May report I announced that one Simon Skipp would be replacing Gary Strain (who is retiring) as the Police contact responsible for coordinating SpeedWatch in the Warwickshire area. We have not received any further information regarding him or his background but following the last SpeedWatch session, we received a rather imperious email from him to say that we were breaking published directives regarding permitted times of operation of which we have never been made aware (in some five years of operation). I have emailed him a robust response inviting him to a face-to-face meeting. I await his reply.
- The Warwick Rural East Councillors' Meeting will take place this evening at Jubilee House in Kenilworth. I shall attend and submit a separate report in due course.
- Cadent, the gas people who have been digging up the A425 for several weeks, have posted notices to the residents of Southam Road informing that gas pipeline replacement to individual properties is to take place from 13 July 2026 until 07 September 2026. This is likely to impact on SpeedWatch sessions on the A425 during this period.
